




The LanGuide results analysis app

A short user's guide



1. Purpose

The LanGuide Results Analysis app enables:


- Examining data on language learners who are using the LG Language Learning app,
- Tracking language learning progress with the LG Language Learning app,
- o Presenting users' learning results based on a selected criterion,
- Downloading data about users and their activity.

2. Access and credentials

- The LanGuide Results analysis app is a web-based app and can be accessed at https://languide.uniri.hr/
- Project members have already been granted access to the app by generating appropriate credentials (username & initial password)
 access rights may be obtained by using the Join Us option near the bottom of the sign in form or by contacting the app administrator at mbrkic@uniri.hr

3. Login

• In order to start working with the app, choose Login on the start page of the official website.




4. Sign in form

Data about the app users can be found in the USERS option of the main menu • A - use Download CSV to save the data to your computer • B - browse data by using Show entries and paging options • C - search through the entries by using appropriate keywords

Results of language learning can be found in the RESULTS option of the main menu

- A use keywords to filter learning results
- B browse data by using *Show entries* and paging options C search through the entries by using appropriate keywords

Data regarding learning results may be filtered using the following

criteria: o user ID

- o exercise ID
- o result (in % or points)
- o max result
- o language
- o skill
- o date range



10. Sorting data

All tabular data may be sorted using the arrow symbols located on the right side of each cell in the table header:

- sorting criterion is indicated by a white arrow
- the direction of the white arrow indicates ascending or descending ordering of the data (mouseclick multiple times to change the ordering)
